year brothers Leo and Jack Rabe purchased Kubicheks Hardware in Blairstown. They renamed the local hardware store and heating shop Rabe Hardware and opened for business on a belief that every customer should be treated like family with honesty, integrity and reliability.

Rabe Hardware continues to honor that legacy today under the direction of Leo's son, Jason (Jake) Rabe. Jake grew up in the family business and at an early age began show-

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ing interest in home mechanical services. In 1994, after serving as an F-18 Fighter Jet Mechanic in the Gulf War, Jake became the second generation owner and continues to own and operate the company today.

"Our goal today is the same as it was 40 years ago – to provide products and services that exceed expectations and to do it with honesty, integrity and reliability," Jake Rabe said.

Under Jake's leadership, the company has significantly expanded services to include far more than could have been imagined by its founders. What started 40 years ago as a small-town operation, has grown to become one of Eastern Iowa's most trusted service companies for quality residential and commercial solar, HVAC, plumbing, electrical and fireplace products and services.

In 2007, Jake purchased Travis True Value in Vinton which is now home to Rabe Hardware's second location called Home Comfort Headquarters. With more than 25 operable fireplace displays including gas, wood and electric as well as a variety of wood and multi-fuel stoves; Home Comfort Headquarters is undoubtedly one of Eastern Iowa's most impressive fireplace showrooms.

Most notable of Rabe Hardware's accom-
